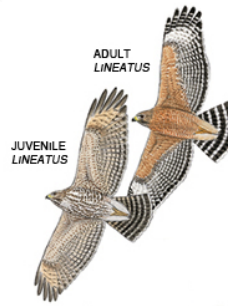

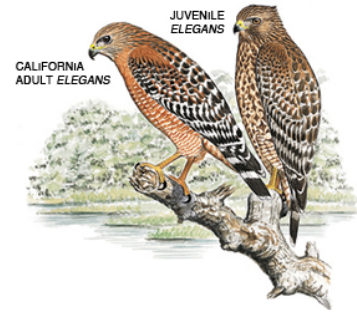
American Robin  
*Turdus migratorius*



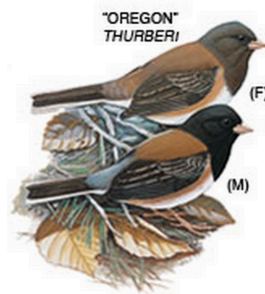
Northern Mockingbird  
*Mimus polyglottos*



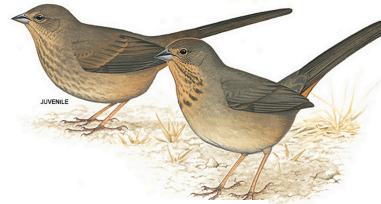
Red-shouldered Hawk

*Aphelocoma californica*



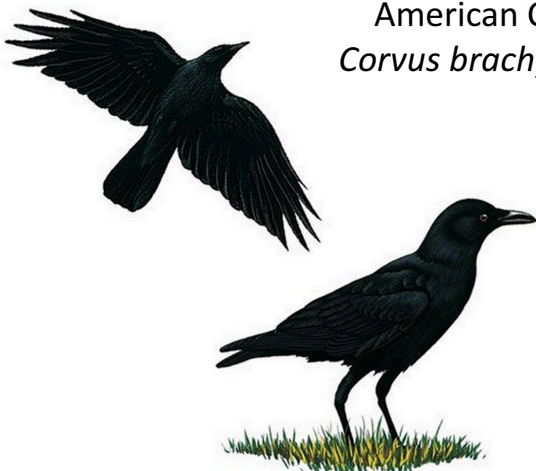
Black-headed Junco

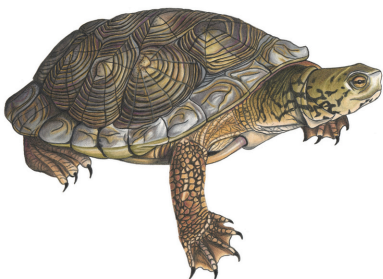
